Wisconsin Virtual School – AP Online Courses

Requirements

The opportunity to take an online AP course is offered to you because you are a strong student who has achieved senior standing. Please know that when learning the material, you will be working the majority of the time independently. You will receive the support through email/fax by your professor, but plan on self-directed learning. Students are expected to meet the state prerequisites in the course descriptions on the WVS website. We know that this course will require a lot of self-discipline and effective time management. This is based on the experience of previous UGHS students. Please consider the rigor of this course and how it will fit into your schedule both in and out of school. Students have 5 months in the fall and spring to complete the requirements. It is recommended that you take the corresponding class(es) offered by UGHS in preparation for the course.

This class is taken in the library during a designated period of the day. You are encouraged to work on the material outside of the school day as well.

Cost

The district is billed for the students who remain enrolled in the course past 14 days. See your counselor if you wish to drop a course. The course is free if you earn a passing grade. If you drop the course after the 14 day limit or if you fail a course, you will be billed for the entire balance of the tuition.

*****If you fail the course or drop the course after the 14 day limit, you will be billed for it. The cost of the course may be or exceed \$400.** If a second semester senior is not on track to pass the course, he/she will be billed for its cost two weeks prior to graduation. Upon successful completion of the course, that student will be reimbursed in full. Additionally, you are required to return any books to Gail Bentley in the District Office. If the book is not returned, you will be charged for the replacement costs.

Transcript

This is a grade weighted class. The grade from this course will go on your transcript and be factored into your rank.
